- ❖ 25-30 Roping and Daubing Cattle (these must be different than the sorting cattle)
- 12-18 head Working Rancher Cattle (potentially, will need 2 or 3 herds of 6 so they can be switched)
- Contractor is expected to provide own feed and care for his/her cattle while they are on grounds –
  - Pens & water tanks are provided.
- Provide glue, numbers, and labor for Cattle Preparation

The Contractor shall hold no member of the Association liable for any debts, fees, or assessments of the Association.

The Contractor will provide liability insurance.
